Praia, Cabo Verde — March 25, 2026

The Human Leaders International Congress Cabo Verde 2026 (HLICCV2026) takes place from July 24 to 25 at the University of Cape Verde Campus, bringing together 500+ global leaders under the theme "Humanized Leadership for a Sustainable and Inclusive Future."

The event positions Cabo Verde as a strategic hub for leadership innovation and dialogue, offering concrete responses to African challenges such as inequality, youth unemployment, and sustainable transition.
